(Registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860)

- Age of the Victims needs to be ascertained through ossification test and if they found to be below 18 years, than provisions under newly enacted POSCO Act needs to be added in FIR against the offenders.
- Role of Jarwa police and Role of staff members of Adim Janjati be examined. It is also required to question these staff and members of Jarawa Police as despite their presence and duty, such a gruesome and heinous crime took place.
- If any of the officials are found to be failing in their duties, which appears to be the case, then appropriate administrative and criminal proceedings should be initiated against them as well.
- An enquiry committee consisting of experts should be set up to examine the incidents and suggest measures to stop such incidents and also to make appropriate recommendations for better administration of Jarawa areas in future to protect the tribe.
