9	<p>Shri. S.A. Awaradi, member of the Group of Experts constituted for the review of Jarawa policy called over phone today and asked for the detailed programme in terms of the order no: 330 dated 27th July 2011.</p>
10	<p>He stated that during the visit to Jarawa area for review of the Jarawa policy, simultaneous visits are required to be undertaken to other primitive tribal areas viz.. the Onges, Shompens and Andamanese for a detailed comparative study vis-a-vis the Jarawas to evaluate and analyze the present position of these tribes and reasons for their lost culture etc...</p>
11	<p>This visit is also required to make necessary recommendations in the policy to protect the Jarawas so that history is not repeated.</p>
12	<p>He has asked to chalk out a detailed programme for 8 to 10 days to cover all the area i.e 3 days for Jarawa area including Strait Island, 3 days for Shompen and Onges and two days for meetings etc. He has requested to fax the detailed programme to obtain administrative approval from Chief Secretary of Delhi Administration.</p>
