It is to mention here that on the aforesaid item is not available in AAJVS office stock, we need to procure the same as desired by Director, Tribal Welfare in his tour report and we do not have any authorized supplier.

Further, it is to mention here that samples of uniforms have been selected by Prof. Vishvajit Pandya and Shri Anup Kr. Mondal, Tribal Welfare Officer, AAJVS Kadamtala. And also last time they were procured from local market i.e. M/s. Daauji Paridhan.

These items approximately cost may come to Rs. 98,000/- (Rupees ninety eight thousand only), as per market survey.

Hence, it is proposed that we may procure the same through approval of purchase committee of AAJVS by inviting quotation from open market.

As per the delegation of financial Powers delegated to the Officers of AAJVS vide order No. 160 dated 08.09.2009 (Item S. No. 15), the Director (TW) is competent authority to approve the above proposal (Please see flag A).
