
(472) May please refer to the notes from para 462 to 471/n above. It is regarding the finalized proposal to provide additional set of school uniform to the Jarawa children. In this connection the comments /suggestions have been sought by ES AAJVS vide his note at para 471/n above.

(473) The matter dealt in above paras relates to two major aspects having ramification on the survival and well-being of the Jarawas, viz (i) schooling and (ii) clothing. It would agitate, at the outset, the goal of the schooling for Jarawa children who would otherwise be learning the essential life skills of hunting - gathering under the guidance of their parents and peers. Further, the textile clothes to the hunters and gatherers living in the humid, eight months wet tropical climate have far reaching impact on the Jarawas.

(474) A & N Administration, in compliance to the judgment Order of the High Court of Calcutta and with approval of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India has notified the Jarawa Policy in 2004 for the well-being and welfare of the Jarawas. This policy is meant to be followed in letter and spirit.

(475) However, the matter dealt in para 462 to 471/n above is essentially an administrative issue and is subsequent to the major administrative decisions already being executed by the AAJVS.
