The Jarawas said that they collected only 50 to 60 nos coconuts, some Banana and bettele nuts from the Agriculture Farm and few from two private farms. He persuaded the Jarawas not to enter into the villages and collect items. He then directed the AAJVS staff to be more vigilant. The Jarawas demanded rice and banana.

To confirm actual incident, self visited Mile Tilak and Jarawa area on 20/12/2012. After discussion with the villagers vis-à-vis the Jarawas the following facts are submitted.

On the day of incident, i.e. 10/12/2012 while proceeding to Jhinga Nallah for extraction of honey, with Shri. V Palaiyan and 04 Police Personnel, the Jarawas saw that some Jarawas of Tirur were standing on the road side at Mile Tilak. The Jarawa sitting in the jeep asked the driver to stop but since it was a residential area, he did not stop. The Jarawas started shouting and banging on the jeep. Few Jarawa jumped from the jeep. On this the driver got frightened and stopped the jeep. All the Jarawas got out from the jeep and interacted with the Jarawas of Tirur. Shri. V. Palaiyan, Janjati Sevak AAJVS persuaded the Jarawas to get into the jeep so that he can take them to Jhinga Nallah. The Jarawas did not obey his words and went into the Jungle for extraction of honey. The Jarawas of Tirur came for collection of wood for making bows. The employees of AAJVS and Police were patrolling on the road.
