Sir,

Kindly find enclosed herewith the  
Statement of Sh. K. Papa Rao, J/S. AJYS, Shri.  
Dhiren Baroi, H/G. JPP. No 4, and the Oarsman of  
the Contract Eldinghi of AJYS, stated that, while  
shifting the discharged Jarawa from PHC T/B  
to Babla Balu on 7/3/13, at about 11 Am, they  
witnessed that two Jarawas at B/Balu were  
under state of intoxication. We had recorded  
the statement of the Jarawa boys (discharged  
from PHC, T/B. and onboard Eldinghi they  
disclosed the facts that one Sujay Roy  
R/O H/road, and Kamal Roy R/O Collimpur  
supplied them liquor beside the other items.

The statement is self explanatory  
and request for suitable action being the  
sensitive issue on the part of welfare and  
protection of the Jarawa tribes.
