

On reaching the shore, the two persons flee way and the Jarawas boarded that unauthorized dinghy. We prepared to take the unauthorized dinghy under custody and tow to Collinpur, but the Jarawas did not allow, the physical assaulted us, aimed the bow / arrow. Some took deadly weapons to attack us. They were under influence of alcohol. We were saved only by the two Jarawas whom we brought from PHC Tusnabad.

Since the situation was very sensitive and threatening, we had no other option but to withdraw. Both the Jarawas also accompanied us as they did not like their fellow Jarawas being drunk. Therefore, we boarded the contract dinghy and reached Collinpur 6 PM and reported the matter to Tribal Welfare Officer.
