This is a letter from the AD (Admn), enclosing a sheet of the minutes of meeting of District planning Committee, South Andaman held from 9th to 11th January 2013 received on 21st May 2013. The points relevant to Tribal Welfare are as under:-

- a) Provision may be kept for compensation to the affected families by Jarawa attack
- b) Shifting of existing AJVS sub-office at Collinpur to some other place at Tirur / Collinpur
- c) Establishment of separate hospital under Jarawa reserve for Jarawa patients
- d) Immediate shifting of Jarawa ward from PHC Tusnabad to Tirur village
- e) Frequent visit of Officials are to be made in Jarawa adjacent areas and also to conduct meetings with respective PRI members
- f) Proper action may be initiated on regular entries of Jarawa at civilian areas under Tusnabad and Tirur village.

In this regard, it is submitted here that all the above matters were deliberated during the General Body meeting of AAJVS held on 20/02/2013. AAJVS is an autonomous body and runs on the sparse grant-in-aid sanctioned by the Administration. Grant-in-aid is not meant for grant of compensation or ex-gratia, This issue is looked after by the office of the Collectorate and the Raj Niwas.

The general Body had already approved for a new Jarawa ward at PHC Ferrargunj. Forest department had already been asked to submit necessary estimates.

The AAJVS office had already been shifted from Collinpur to Maymyo / Herbertabad.

The District Administration has been requested to allot land at Tirur for c/o Jarawa ward. On allotment, the Jarawa ward at Tusnabad shall be shifted. Other points are also frequently looked into.

If approved, we may send a copy of this note to the Assistant Director (Admn) for further necessary action.
