Administration committed to protect Jarawa tribe from exploitation, strict action against violators: Dte of Tribal Welfare

Port Blair, Oct. 10

It was reported that about 10 Jarawas of Kadamtala area of North and Middle Andaman District came out from the Jungle on 3rd October, 2013 and met the village Pradhan demanding rice and iron tools.

In press release received here today, the Asst Commissioner (TW) has stated that the incident was got enquired carefully by the Tribal Welfare Officer of AAJVS with the Jarawas concerned, who divulged that Maharaja Bala alias Raja S/o Late Hari Bala, resident of Kadamtala, Suresh Xaxa S/o Banadick Xaxa, resident of Kadamtala, Surender alias Suren S/o Lakpati, resident of Broombally, Swapan Biswas alias Toko S/o Bhagirat Biswas, resident

of Broombally had been frequently visiting the Jarawa habitat within the Tribal Reserve Area for poaching and used to hunt the wild boar. They also supplied intoxicating liquor

and tobacco to Jarawas. Only on the instigation of Maharaja Bala, the Jarawas were taken to meet the Pradhan and the incident was stage managed with
