**Sub: Newspaper clipping of 'Andaman Chronicle' dated 28.10.2013 under the caption "Tirur Jarawa Reserve: 'Hotspot' of negligence"**

Kindly refer to Secretary to LG's Note No. SLG/PR-2013 (105) dated 29.10.2013 forwarding therewith a newspaper clipping (copy enclosed).

2. The enquiry conducted by SHO Ograbranj reveals that on 18/10/2013 one Jarawa girl namely Thorwathal aged about 35 yrs was brought to PHC Tushnabad from Bamboo Nalli, Tirur by Shri Navdeep Mondal, staff of AAJVS with a history of injury sustained by falling down from a tree. She was admitted in the hospital for medical treatment.

3. During enquiry, the Tribal Welfare Officer, AAJVS, Tirur, disclosed that on 18/10/2013 one Jarawa boy namely Anjana wanted to have sexual relationship with the Jarawa girl 'Thorwathal' but on denial the Jarawa boy Anjana assaulted her with a chopper. However, the Jarawa girl did not disclose anything regarding this incident to the Medical Authority or AAJVS staff.

4. The report published in the local Newspaper "Andaman Chronicle" dated 28/10/13 that the Jarawa consumed liquor is without any substance since it has emerged during enquiry that she had sustained injury due to assault by Anjana, a Jarawa boy.

5. To prevent poaching activities in the Jarawa Reserve Areas, the staff of OP Tirur and JPP Tirur No.1 (A) conduct regular patrolling in association with the staff of AAJVS and Forest Department. So far no Jarawas have been noticed/found under influence of alcohol or psychotropic substances.

6. Presently one (1) HC, two (2) PCs and 01 HG are being kept as reserve exclusively for patrolling alongwith AAJVS staff. During the current year 03 cases at PS Ograbraj, 03 cases at PS Kadamtala and one case at PS Baratang under PAT Regulations have been registered.

7. The Incharges of OP Tirur and JPP Tirur No. 1 (A) have been directed to keep vigil on the activities of settlers in their respective areas.
