With Reference to the Memo F.No.11-2/AAJVS/2012/710 dated, the 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct, 2013 the Enquiry has been made with the Field Staff Mr. Sukh Bahadur, he deployed on duty at Choubrigumai on 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2013 and it is found that the Complainee is not residing at Survey no. 21, situated at Jirkatang but once on a while he visit his Plot, and the Plot Comes adjacent to the Jarawa Reserve which is approximately 350 meters inside of JPP Check Post.

The Movement of Jarawas are very often for Hunting and Gathering in this area.

According to the Quantity and items of losses mentioned in the Complain was found incorrect and the number of Jarawas mentioned was also found wrong.

According to the enquiry I came to know, on that day the Population of Choubrigumai was 38 (Male - 8, Female - 9 and children - 21) from this total Population
