Based on the depositions made by the Jarawas, a FIR was lodged in the Kadamtala PS by the Tribal Welfare Officer to take criminal action against the named accused. Accordingly, the Police have filed a criminal case bearing No. 31/13 against the four accused persons under Section 7/8 (2) (6) of the A&N Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) Regulation, 1956. The committing of unauthorized entry into the Tribal Reserve Area, poaching of the resources therein, supplying of tobacco and liquor to tribals are very serious offences for which sentences upto Seven years imprisonment could be imposed. The above said four accused has already been arrested by the Police. The Administration is committed to protect the Jarawa tribe from exploitation and therefore strict action will be taken against unscrupulous elements who violate the law.
