Sub:- Security to AAJVS staff posted at Tirur area – reg.

Sir,

As you are aware that recently the AAJVS and Police team apprehended seven persons who entered into the Jarawa Reserve area and involved in the illegal activities with the Jarawa Tribes. FIR has already been lodged at P.S Kadamtala and P.S Ograbraj and the seven persons are on judicial custody.

The field staff of AAJVS and the Police who napped the culprits are now receiving threatening calls. Yesterday i.e on 23.1.2014 while recording the statement at Kadamtala by Shri Sebastian, Dy.S.P, Rangat one AAJVS staff namely Debrata Mondal posted at Tirur area received threatening call which was also heard by the Dy.S.P. Shri Debrata Mondal now shifted to Kadamtala temporarily from Tirur area.

Similar threatening calls were also received by other staff of AAJVS who were part of the search operation in the Jarawa Reserve area on 16th and 17th January, 2014.

It is apprehended that after the release of this seven persons they may create problem with the field staff of AAJVS at Tirur area as such, it is, requested that protection may be provided to the field staff of AAJVS at the office which is situated at Temple Myo village.

It is also requested that the Police personals may be asked to accompany AAJVS team while they are on patrolling in the reserve areas and in the villages when the Jarawas enter the settlement areas.
