At the outset the Secretary (TW) formally welcomed the participants. Then the agenda points were taken-up for deliberation. After detailed discussion on various issues the following decisions were taken.

**1. Tirur Jarawa situation**

In view of the recent unlawful activities by some unscrupulous elements among the settlers (Non-Tribals) in relation to the Jarawas including unruly behaviour of a few Jarawas of Tirur area, it was observed that there was lack of coordination among different departments, particularly Police involved in protection of the Jarawas. Hence it was unanimously agreed that the jurisdiction of the IGP, who has been designated as Nodal Officer for Law and Order on ATR by the Administration could be further
