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extended to whole Jarawa reserve territory to ensure prompt and positive coordination from the Police. Necessary proposal shall be moved immediately. Periodic coordination meeting of the TW, Police & Forest Departments should be held to sort out field level issues.

Gender issues are to be examined by the Research Associates. Both settlers and Jarawas are to be sensitized.

- Counseling of Jarawas who are engaged in unlawful activities with settlers (non-tribals outside the ATR).
- Yearly examination of performance of AAJVS workers and Tribal Welfare Officer.

(Action by Dte.of TW, ES, AAJVS & ANTRI)

2. Legal Issues

(a) AAJVS shall collect the details of criminal cases filed and kept pending in courts till date so as to pursue with the Public Prosecutor for expeditious disposal and award of punishment to the offenders to serve as deterrent. The Secretary (TW) desired to hold periodical Joint meeting with the Police and PP to review the pendency of the criminal cases in various Courts for remedial measures.

(b) It was decided to identify the habitual offenders under PAT Regulation including PoA Act along with the details of the cases registered / filed against them in order to bind them for good behavior under CrPC. The AC (Tribal Welfare) may be conferred with the powers of an Executive Magistrate under CrPC for the Jarawa Reserve Area and buffer zone area in South Andaman District to deal with habitual / repeated offenders. Necessary proposal in this regard should be moved immediately.

(Action by ES, AAJVS/Dte. of TW)

3. Hot Spots

The Hot Spot structures already completed at different locations in the Jarawa Reserve should be made functional on priority by undertaking community building exercise by the respective Tribal Welfare Officer as community bond among the Jarawas particularly the younger generation of Jarawa, Tirur area has been found eroding over the years.

(Action by ES, AAJVS)
