Sub: Deployment of staff at LOP, Lewis Inlet Bay-reg.

Sir,

I would like to inform you that due to shortage of staff at Kadamtala area since last two years no staff of AAJVS has been deployed at LOP, Lewis inlet bay as it was earlier mentioned in monthly progress report several times. To control poaching and unauthorized entrance of non-tribes in Jarawa reserve area and to check the movement of Jarawas in and around Hanspuri and Sippy Tikrey area it is required to deploy at least two AAJVS staff at LOP, Lweis inlet bay otherwise any unwanted incident may be occurred like past. The DySP North Andaman also informed that during this year 26 times Jarawas came at Hanspuri villages through Lewis Inlet bay. In this connection the following staff posted at Middle Strait and Kadamtala area may be deployed at LOP, Lewis Inlet Bay on rotation basis for 45 days.
