3. Though it is a fact that wild boar is still staple diet of Jarawas, Jarawas are also regularly consuming rice, spices, coconut, banana, Jackfruits etc. collected through underhand/illegal barter with the settler as AAJVS does not supply these items to them. This matter is to be deliberated with the Experts members of RAB of ANTRI on 30.12.2013.
4. AAJVS staff with help of local police can carry out patrolling in the Tirur/Jhaukona area by Engine Dinghi to prevent poaching but for Badabhoja, Badabalu & Hiren Tekri area a speed boat is necessary. It has come to the notice the some poachers approach the area of Badabhoja, Badabalu & Hiren Tekri from Wandoor side. AAJVS staff tried to chase them in the past but could catch them due to speed variation. So speed boat may be provided to both AAJVS staff and the police posted at Jarawa Protection Post IV.
5. In addition the police posted at Wandoor may be instructed to keep watch on the poachers coming to west coast from Wandoor side.
