It has come to the notice the some poachers approach the area of Badabhoja, Badabalu & Hiren Tekri from Wandoor side. AAJVS staff tried to chase them in the past but could catch them due to speed variation. So speed boat may be provided to both AAJVS staff and the police posted at Jarawa Protection Post IV.
