Two FIR's were lodged at Kadamtala Police Station and one was transferred to Police Station Ograbraj, details of the FIR are as under:-
	-8	Few Jarawas viz. Anjale, Aninjamu, Elangato and Titaiothey passed a information to Tribal Welfare Officer, Tirur on 14/1/2014 that a poacher that viz. Narayan Roy Alias Sujoy and his group came to Jhaokona and took Jarawa girls in their dinghy. The Jarawa girls were Baliyawey, Thiyane, Aninja and Loyela and proceeded to Hiren Tikery and not retuned back.
3	180	On receipt of the information Dr. Pronob Kumar Sircar accompanied by Janjati Sevaks and one Police constable from Out Post Tirur and Forest Officials conducted surveillance in western coast of South Andaman on 16/1/2014. They left about 1700 hrs and reached Hiren Tikery. They searched the poachers and the Jarawas whole night but could not locate. On the next morning i,e 17th January 2014 at around 0700 hrs, they reached the spot and found that the following persons in an engine dinghy
		i) Narayan Roy, alias Sujoy S/o Khoken Roy, R/o Herbertabad / Wandoor / Diglipur ii) V. Kumar Raja alias bablu, S/o PVG Kumar, R/o Herbertabad iii) Sambu Bepari S/o Late Rajan Bepari, R/o Herbertanad.
T.	BI	The Jarawa girls viz Baliyawey, THiyane, Aninja and Loyela were sent for crab hunting in different locations of tyhe creek which is surrounded by crocodile. The Jarawas who accompanied got emotional and manhandled the poachers. The father of one of the Jarawa girl got extremely angry and attacked them with a dha. He was controlled with great difficulty. Later he shouted name of his daughter who heard the voice and rushed to her father.
	162	All the girls were shifted back to Jhao Kona in the authorized dinghy. The apprehended poachers and their three dinghies were brought to Uttara jetty at around 1715 hours on 17/01/2014.
