Besides, four volunteers, two from Herbartabad village, one each from Collinpur and Tirur village belonging to Bengali settlers community have been appointed on payment of an honorarium of Rs. 3000/- PM as approved by CS vide para 227/N (P-284/C) to keep watch on the Jaraw movement towards the settlements and non-tribal settlers (poachers) intrusion into the Jarawa reserve vice-versa including sensitization of the settlers to harmful effects on the Jarawas as a result of their intrusion into the Jarawa territory and exploitation of the Jarawa tribe.

In another successive interaction with over 25 Jarawa women including adolescent girls of Tirur area on 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2014 two lady Research Associates of ANTRI could establish good <sup>2 report</sup> ~~report~~ with them. They even accompanied 10 Jarawa girls on fishing and observed that the Jarawa girls have fair idea of location of fish concentration in the sea.

Each of the Jarawa women present during interaction was provided with a Maxi. In this regard a copy of the report dt. 11/4/2014 submitted by the research team is placed at PP-287-288/C for reference.

An engine dinghy with a capacity of carrying 20 persons at a time has been acquired from the Fisheries Department and positioned at Tirur so as to strengthen the Joint Patrolling from the Seaward side of the Jarawa reserve. Now the engine dinghi is available for use at any time required in emergent situation. The Joint patrolling has been intensified to eliminate the poaching into the Jarawa reserve particularly in Tirur area. Procurement and distribution of Dah and other implements to the Jarawas are being arranged locally by the respective TWOs.
