The lady officials from ANTRI should interact and provide the items while sensitizing the Jarawa women regularly at least for a period of week and continue to assess their behavioural changes.

- The team persuaded the Jarawa women not to take things from the settlers (non-tribals) and also advised not to interact with the villagers at any point of time.
- 3. The Jarawas are demanding for rice and other items and they insisted that if it is provided to them they will not interact with the villagers. The Jarawa boy namely Kunnu informed that if we provide two bags of rice, he will distribute the rice to all the families now staying in the camp.

## Immediate Introduction of Exchange System:-

- The Jarawas were demanding the iron implements vis dah, spade, file, axe for their immediate requirement. Since these items are being supplied, the TWO shall provide it immediately to the Jarawas.
- 2. To avoid the villagers bartering with the tribes and exploitation, Jarawa boys were asked to prepare baskets, honey containers and other items and on making these items and giving it to AAJVS staff, the staff shall provide rice, dal, salt, turmeric powder on the next day. The Jarawa wanted 2 bag of rice (50 kg)

The Jarawas agreed and they requested to take few Jarawas to Puna Nallah where the particular timber is available for carving the honey container. The Jarawa has also informed that the ladies shall prepare the basket and five baskets will be ready within three-four days.

The AAJVS should be ready with these items and give it to the Jarawas at the Jhaokona Hot Spot. If the persuasion is not implemented, the mistrust of the Jarawas on the AAJVS staff may erode and the tribes may approach the villagers again for bartering their product.

Entering of tribes in the villagers frequently and taking away their plantation crops by the tribes, the villagers are coming up openly accusing the administration for not providing relief to them for the damage caused to their plantation and under water current is prevailing. The situation may explode at any point of time if the intervention is not introduced on emergent basis.
