A new boat (engine dinghi) approaching to our boat with some 20 Jarawas on board, and tried to snatch the item and catches from our boat. We returned to Collinpur and enquiry the matter with AAJVS staff, it reveals that no Engine dinghi was hired for shifting the Jarawa etc. on the said day and time.

More over it was also observed that the engine dinghi of the tenderer of engine dinghi to AAJVS use to shift the Jarawas from one place another with some vested interest (without any informing to the AAJVS staff) some time they also transit the Jarawa to the settlement area during night time. The advantage taken by the tenderer of engine dinghi to AAJVS. Which is seems to be very harmful for the Jarawa and the settlers of the area in future.
