

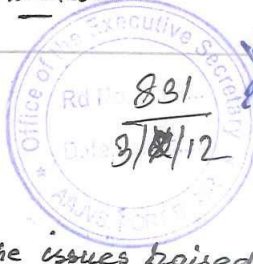

Subj: Detail Report on the issues raised by one Sh. Mahesh Majumdar. Regd.

Sir, With reference to the memorandum No. 373 dt. 26/9/2012. received on 29/9/2012 evening, regarding the above mentioned Subject -

That Sir, on 28th Sept. 2012. Some three four fishermen including the Complainant Sh. Mahesh Majumdar, were on fishing trip (with a hired E/dinghi) to Badabalu area. On their way to the area of fishing, while reaching or about to reach the area, One E/dinghi was sighted near the Badabalu area and approaching to the fishing dinghi, when position was nearer it was observed that some Jarawas were on board the E/dinghi, and warn the fishing dinghi to stop, but the fishing dinghi somehow reached to C/Pur. (as statement. at A. B. - enclosed).

The E/dinghi with Jarawa moving the area was not a authorized one, AJVS, has not engaged any E/dinghi in order to shift the Jarawa on that day. Tender of E/dinghi (AJVS) also not supplied any dinghi for shifting the Jarawa on 28/9/12. (Copy of statement enclosed). (C.D)

Jarawa moving from one place to another on that day (28/9/2012) was other fisherman's E/dinghi, the member of fishing team (Complainant) stated that they can identify the E/dinghi if given chance.

However, the fisherman and other E/dinghi owner were also shift the Jarawa from one area to another, as add. by the Complainant. It is a matter of investigation by the Police, specially. Chowki No. 4. at Collipur, TIRUR. Ph.
