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I am to inform you that: Seven Jarawas (three male and four female) entered in to the Plantation of Collinpur area on 15th Oct. 2012 at about 2.30 Pm. The Jarawa team was headed by one Alamalaye (male Adult). They come from Thookona (Their temporary camp) via Kalikona near the JPP. Chowki No. 4. with the intension of picking and collection of leaves from the Creek area, later they entered in to the adjacent plantation area, and it is reported by the three farm owner and headmaster of Govt. Primary School Collinpur that: Jarawas (visiting) were also taken the following farm produce while returning to Thookona -

1. Sh. Monojit Biswas - R/o Collinpur -
 - Banana - about 100kg, • Black TarpaLine - 1 No.
 - Sickle - 1 No.
2. Sh. Balram Singh - R/o Collinpur -
 - Daw - 2 Nos, • Spade - 1 No, • Banana - approx 60kg.
 - Supari - 50kg (approx), • TarpaLine - 1 No. (10'x12')
3. Sh. Sharat Kirtuniya, R/o Collinpur -
 - Banana - 30kg (approx), • Spade - 1 No.
4. Head Master, Govt. Primary School Collinpur -
 - Coconut - 10 Nos, • Banana - 20kg (approx).
 (from the school premises)

Matter was enquire and found that the Jarawas had taken the item and Banana, but they said that Supari was not taken by them - (Preliminary finding).
