

Luis-in-Let-Bay:- One team for joint patrolling from Luis-in-Let-Bay to Flat Island.

Kadamtala:- Two teams (One for foot patrolling and other for sea patrolling from Flat Island to Port Compbel).

Baratang:- One team (Foot as well as creek patrolling).

- 4. Information Display:-** List of listed tourist spots to be shown at main places. Such sign board should be displayed by restaurant/hotel owners to ensure accurate information for tourists and to avoid illegal intrusion in the Jarawa reserved areas.

- 5. Maintenance of Register on Landing Points:-** A register containing details of passengers/fishermen, details of dinghies, purpose of visits, materials/equipments carried etc. should be maintained by Police at landing points where tourists arrive such as (1). Austin Creek, (2). Chainpur Dinghy Ghat, (3). Tugapur Forest jetty, (4). Yeterjig No. 11, (5). Bamboo Tikrey, (6). Kadamtala jetty, (7). Nilambur jetty & (8) Flat Bay.

- 6. Requirement of Dug Out Bonga Dinghy:-** Shri. Anup Kumar Mondal, T.W.O, Kadamtala suggested to provide dug out bonga dinghy each at Middle Strait and Luis-in-Let-Bay to check the activities of fishing dinghies/poachers in the Jarawa reserve areas.

Profile of Fishermen:-** A discussion on the matter was held where it was concluded to find out the details of fishermen of North & Middle Andaman along with their photographs to identify easily the intruders by showing the photographs to Jarawas. The undersigned directed Shri. S.K.Talukdar, Asstt. Director, Fisheries, Mayabunder to make available the details of fishermen along with their photographs so that the joint patrolling team could identify the dinghies of fishermen who entered the Jarawa reserve area by showing them to concerned Jarawas.
