

- 5. Maintenance of Register on Landing Points:-** A register containing details of passengers/fishermen, details of dinghies, purpose of visits, materials/equipments carried etc. should be maintained by police at landing points where tourists/fishermen arrive such as Austin Creek, Chainpur Dinghy Ghat, Tugapur Forest Jetty, Yeterjig No. 11, Bamboo Tikrey, Kadamtala Jetty & Nilambur Jetty.

- 6. Profile of Fishermen:-** A discussion on the matter was held where it was concluded to find out the details of fishermen of N&M Andaman District along with their photographs to identify easily the intruders by showing the photograph to Jarawas.

- 7. Convoy Issue:-** Shri Ajay Kumar Rai, SDPO Rangat pointed out that Jarawas regularly insists on ride in the tail car of convoy, if Police refuse they become annoyed. It may lead to some avoidable incident. Thus, the SP(D) N&M Andaman directed Shri Anup Kumar Mondal, TWO, AAJVS, Kadamtala to take up the matter at appropriate level.
