5. The Ex. Secy(AAJVS) informed that one boat provided from PMF is under repair which needs repair. The SP(SA) clarified that since the boat has been provided to AAJVS, hence the maintenance and repair work is to be undertaken by AAJVS itself.

- 6. The Asst. Director, Fisheries pointed out that the jarawas and villagers/fishermen are indulging in barter system with each other. The SP(SA) expressed that this system should be discouraged. The Ex. Secy(AAJVS) also mentioned that this is violation of Jarawa Policy. SP(SA) told that police, AAJVS, Forest should sensitize the villagers, fishermen etc. not to indulge in any exchange of food items with the Jarawas and maintain strict vigil over outsiders, poachers, tourists, tour operators etc. not to do such activity.
- 7. The Asst. Director (Fisheries) informed that 42 fishing boats are plying and out of them 11 are motorized. Colour coding of the boats is to be carry out. Presently no fisheries staff is posted at Tirur. SP(SA) advised that fisheries deptt. should provide GPS for their safety in the sea and the same can be monitored easily about their movements and it will also helpful for the fishermen to avoid security agency to collect intelligence.
- 8. Ms. M. Janagi Savuriyammal, T.W.O., AAJVS, Tirur, pointed out that one person namely Sujoy involved in contacting Jarawas earlier still visits Tirur. On this SDPO Bambooflat clarified that Sujoy whose actual name is Narayan Roy had involvement in a number of PAT cases is presently not in Tirur. He is living at Wandoor. SP(SA) directed SDPO(Bambooflat) to maintain strict watch over his activities.
- 9. Ms. M. Janagi Savuriyammal also suggested for placing a check post of Forest to check illegal transportation of wild life and sea products. SP(SA) assured that matter will be apprised to the Forest Department.
