He suggested that they are ready to sell their products to Govt. in market rate to give to Jarawas if the Govt. comes forward for purchase. Further he pointed out that only 2 AAJVS staff is posted for entire Jirkatang area which is for name sake only as they have no control over Jarawas. He suggested that atleast 10 more AAJVS staff should be posted in Jirkatang.

The undersigned has informed that the matter will be conveyed to the AAJVS.

Shri C. Moideen, villager Jirkatang: -

He stated that he has got arecanut & coconut garden at Jirkatang No.6. The Jarawas come in the garden and say that they are hungry. If he refuses to give coconut Jarawas will threaten and they take Coconut and arecanut from his plantation. Jarawas even threaten not to report the matter to the Police. Jarawas eat Coconut but what for Jarawas take the areca nut he does not know. Surprisingly, these eatable are being taken by Jarawas in AAJVS vehicle and AAJVS staff does not bother to refuse Jarawas.

He further stated that if the Jarawas are given the food items inside jungle they will never come out of the jungle. The jarawas are coming out of the jungle in search of food and it is their hunger and starvation forcing them to come to the civilian area.

The undersigned has informed that the matter will be conveyed to the AAJVS.

<u>Shri A. Kunju Moideen, villager Jirkatang: -</u>

He pointed out that he has got coconut plantation at Jirkatang No.6. It is the normal practice that Jarawas come and take Coconut in AAJVS vehicle and AAJVS staff neither refuses nor recovers the coconuts. Further they have written to the Tehsildar as earlier they were getting compensation, Tehsildar inspected spot, took photography but nothing has been done and these days they don't get any compensation.
