### SUGGESTIONS

1. It is the high time that concerned agencies must take decisions to provide Jarawas with regular ration articles inside the Forest. Once their hunger is satisfied they would not come of the forest. If the present situation prevails then forecasting of cases of serious nature by Jarawas could not be ruled out.
2. Barter system is prevalent in Hiren Tekri and Bada Balu. Hiren Tekri is nearer to PS Kadamatala than PS Ograbraj. Further in Monsoon season police party could not sail from Tirur area to Hiren Tekri as such PS Kadamatala marine assets should be pressed for keeping surveillance in Hiren Tekri.
3. The area under OP Tirur is very vast. In comparison only 11 staff has been provided. To put an end into the intrusion additional 10 Police Constables need to be deployed at OP Tirur.
