Further the recent incident of Jarawa accompanying a civilian in his house leading to registration of case brings shame to the whole community. The villagers should refrain from entering into the Reserved area as well keep the police informed if any Jarawas are entering in the Civilian area. Villagers as well as the Fishermen are the "Eyes and Ears" of the Police, more information sharing will prevent and curb the menace related to Jarawas. It was made clear to the members that if at all Jarawas violates the law in the civilian area, prompt legal action would be initiated by registering the case against the Jarawas henceforth.
