

5. Ms: M. Janagi Savuriyammal, T.W.O., AAJVS, Tirur, informed that Narayan Roy @ Sujoy involved in many PAT cases was reportedly seen in Tirur on 29/2/2016. SHO has been advised to keep a sharp watch over his activities.

6. As raised by Ms. M. Janagi Savuriyammal during previous meeting, for placing a check post of Forest department to check illegal transportation of wild life and sea products, in this regard Shri A.C. Tilak, ACF, F/D, South Andaman stated that suitable place near jeep stand at Tushnabad was identified. But later it was considered that it was not effective for checking as there was scope of escape of culprits from other link road at Tushnabad. Hence, the entrance of the Haddipur village road has been identified and necessary proposal has been submitted to higher officials.

7. SDPO/Bambooflat was informed during the last meeting that Forest department has repaired some JPPs at Middle Andaman from forest products. Forest department may be requested to also repair JPPs at Tirur. In this regard it was also informed that half of balance amount has been released and the Construction work is in progress.

SP/SA stated that it was verified from SHO Kadamtala whether he needs repair of JPPs from Forest. He informed that earlier there was a proposal for getting three temporary structure of JPPs ie. Parlobjig-15, parlobjig-3 and Aderjig-9 repaired from forest produce by Forest department, but later the proposal was dropped as PHQ is going to construct prefabricated JPPs at Kadamala and Middle Strait. One RCC building for JPP Bamboo Tikery at Kadamtala is in progress.

8. SHO Ograbraj had requested during the last meeting to direct PMF boat at Kadamtala to conduct patrolling at Hiran Tikery/Defence Island as this patrolling is quite far from Wandoor whereas it is nearer to Kadamtala. In this regard Insp. PMF informed that the patrolling is being undertaken by PMF boat of Kadamtala. But the PMF Boat MV Santook was under repair and now it has been repaired and sent to PS Kadamtala.

9. SP/SA directed to write to Fisheries department for stringent action against the fishermen who were apprehended in PAT Reg. for trespassing into jarawa reserve area.
