


10. Shri A.C. Tilak, ACF, South Andaman requested to allow forest staff to enter Jarawa reserve area through JPP Jirkatang beyond convoy timings.

In this regard SP/SA asked him to give the same in writing so that their request be forwarded to Tribal Welfare, A&N Administration for taking a suitable decision.

11. SDPO/Bambooflat informed that during summer, jarawas use to come out from jungle in search of food articles as there would be scarcity of food articles in the jungle. In this regard SP/SA suggested to make arrangements by AAJVS and agencies to keep extra vigil. They should be counseled appropriately by AAJVS.

SP/SA directed PMF, SHOs Humfrigungj and Ograbraj to intensify sea patrolling as last month dinghies were apprehended near North Sentinel Island and to hold meetings with game fishing & other Tourist boat operators as well as fishermen to ensure that no contravention of the existing rules & regulation taken place.
