APPLICABILITY OF THE SCHEME:

The scheme would be applicable to all the residents of A&N Islands and tourists visiting the A&N Islands, who sustain/undergo such distress.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA:

For availing financial assistance, the application in the prescribed format should be submitted alongwith the following documents:

> For Grievous Injuries/Death

- I. First Information Report from the Police Station concerned.
- II. Medical Certificate issued by a doctor from the nearest Government Hospital/Dispensary.
- III: Recommendation of the Assessment Committee.

> For Damage caused due to fire accidents/inclement weather:

- I. First Information Report from the Police Station concerned.
- II. Certification by the Chief Fire Officer/Fire Officer.
- III. Recommendation of the Assessment Committee.

For Damage/Theft of the Agricultural Crops/Equipments/ Household Articles due to Jarawa attack:

- I. First Information Report from the Police Station Concerned.
- II. Report from the AAVJS/Tribal Welfare Department.
- III. Recommendation of the Assessment Committee.
