- 7. Instructions to the owners of the hotels/dhabas:-
- > Instructions to the owners of the hotels/dhabas to be issued by the DC/Tourism Department regarding Point No. 04 of the "Protocol of Surveillance" issued vide annexure to order No. 405 Department of Tribal Welfare Administration dated 28th November, 2014. District SsP to follow up with DC/Tourism Department.
