This is a report on joint patrolling conducted on 18th January 2018.

The joint patrolling was conducted on 18 January 2018 by engaging dinghy of the Forest Department and AAJVS HDPE boat. The team proceeded to Bada balu from Collinpur consisting of officials from Police, Forest and AAJVS. On the way the checked two fishing boats but nothing objectionable and they has maintained considerable distance from the Jarawa reserve area.

Thereafter, they reached Badaballu by 0850 hrs and found one engine dinghy bearing No: MV Sahik.and.SA. M.O 703, fitted with 14 HP Kirloskar engine. They anchored near the Jarawa reserved area as spotted by the GPS and were ready for diving. The team intercepted them before they started to flee in to open sea. They found ice box, diving fins, diving glass, jery can, fishing lines, dah etc. the five fisherman were handed over to the Police for further legal action.

An FIR was registered against them vide FIR No: 10/18 dated 18 January 2018 at 3:15 hrs at Police Station Ograbraj. The Tribal Welfare Officer has enclosed photographs of the engine dinghy and the persons.
