Sir,

I am to inform you that the joint patrolling was conducted on 23/04/2018 by the joint patrolling team (police, AAJVS, Forest deptt.) using our speed boat HDPE-90 HP. The team proceed to Badaballu today at about 0600 Hrs from collinpur near (AAJVS field office) while reaching badaballu at about 0700 Hrs, we found an engine dinghy passing there; we stop the engine dinghy and search them. No objectionable item was found in the dinghy bearing Regn. No IND-AN-SA-MO-703, MV SANIKA. There were six crew members on the board, we warn them not to entre in to the Jarawa reserved area and let them go. However they were maintained considerable distance from Jarawa reserved area. We halt at Bada ballu and had breakfast; Patrolling was done in the nallha, Proceed to Collinpur by 11⁴⁵ Hrs from Badaballu and reached Collinpur by 12⁴⁵ Hrs.
