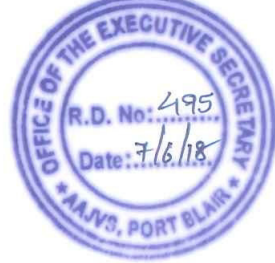

I am to inform you that the joint patrolling was conducted on 27/05/2018 by the joint patrolling team consisting of the officials of AAJVS - Dr Bisweswar Das T.W.O, Mahesh Mazumder Boat man, POLICE- Shri Someswar Rao SI i/c OP Tirur H/C Basheer, P/C John, FOREST - M. Khalid F/G II, Proceed to Badabalu from Temple Meo by our HDPE 90 HP Speed boat at about 0830 hrs and back to c/Pur near AAJVS field office at about 1245 Hrs on the someday.

Joint Patrolling team proceed to Badabalu from Temple meo by HDPE 90 HP Speed boat at about 0830 Hrs, reached Pulber point/ Lall Balu by 9000 Hrs due to very rough weather and heavy wind and waves in the sea, we halt there and back to c/pur VIA Lalbalu, Jhookona and Badanallha / JPP no 4 at about 1245 Hrs.

No illegal activity was found during patrolling in the Jarawa reserved area.

Another joint patrolling was conducted on 31/05/2018 the team proceed to Badabalu from c/pur near AAJVS field office by Forest Engine dinghy at about 0945 Hrs managed to reach up to Badabalu. Patrolling was done in the area (Nallha and creek) halt at Bamboonallha, had lunch at the camp, back to c/pur by late evening reach c/pur by 1730 Hrs on the same day.
