Mr. Sarfudeen Head Constable, Mr. Krishna Rao, Constable of Police out post Tirur, Forest Deptt. Mr. M. Khalid F.G.I, (Smt: Mariyamma, AHM, AAJVS also accompanied) with the team in order to providing medical health coverage to the Jarawa fellow members camping in the West Coastal area.)

Team proceed to Radabali area from Collinpur at about 0830 hrs. and reached up to Lal Balai (Pupper Bay Point) from where we couldn't proceed further towards Rockbali due to strong wind and rough sea, we walked up to 2-3 km in the sea shore and reached up to the Jarawas camp at Bamboo Nalha, (Patrolling was done in the sea shore area and provided health coverage to the present Jarawa fellow members.) and back to Lal Balai and Patrolling was conducted with the speed boat in the area of Jhookra Pathar Nalha and Radabali from 1300 hrs to 1330 hrs, had lunch at JPP No. 4.
