Sub: Trespassing in to the Jarawa reserved area, Reg.

Sir,

I am to inform you that the following fisherman/Persons of Wandoor area - (1. Arun Mondal s/o Bhupen Mondal, 43yr. 2. Bijay Baroi s/o Late Biswanath Baroi s/o. 3. Lal Mohammed s/o Late. Abdul Mohammed 45yr. 4. Narayan Ray @ Sujoy s/o Khoken Ray 20yr) had proceed to Heerentikery from Wandoor on 09/8/2018 at about 0630 hrs. with two personal engine bearing Regn. No. IND-AN-SI-MO. 1106 (MV Kabita) and Regn. No. IND-AN-SA-MO 11 (MV Madhavi). They reached H/Tikery at about 1230 hrs. on the same day. They are at Heerentikery for three four days and doing their job there, since Heerentikery is the Jarawa reserved area. Their entry in the Heerentikery area is an offence.

We may also ref. the signal of SHO Humpigunj vide No. 1505 dt. 22/8/2018. on the basis of missing report lodged by the kin of the said fisherman. A searching expedition was made by the SHO Humpigunj on 23/8/18 and they traced two person and with a engine (part of engine) near Heerentikery. They were brought to Wandoor on the same day.

Consequence of that a Joint Investigation/Interrogation with the four persons was conducted at Police Station, Ogra Bay on 29/8/2018 at about 10:30 AM. (Copy enclosed).

Keeping in view the outcome of the Interrogation it is clear that the fisherman are in the Jarawa reserve area for three four day for fishing etc. It is therefore request kindly to do the needful for the offence done by the above mention fisherman, Pls.
