Sub: Trespassing in to the Jarawa reserved area, Reg.

Sir,

I am to inform you that the following fisherman/Persons of Wandoor area - (1. Arun Mondal s/o Chupen Mondal, 43 yr. 2. Bijay Baroi s/o Late Krishnath Baroi) 59y. 3. Lal Mohammed s/o Late Abdur Mohammed 65y. 4. Narayan Ray @ Sujoy s/o Khokan Ray 30y.) had proceeded to their tikay from Wandoor on 09/8/2018 at about 0630hrs. with two personal Eclingshi bearing Regn. No. IND-AN-SI-MO-106 (MV kabita) and Regn. No. IND-AN-SA-MO-41 (MV madhab). They reached H/Jikay at about 1230 hrs on the same day. They are at their tikay for three days and doing their job there, since their tikay is the Jarawa reserved area. Their entry in the Jarawa area is an offence.

We may also brief the signal of SHO HumpoGanj vide No. 1605 dt. 22/8/2018. on the basis of missing report lodged by the kin of the said fishermen. A searching expedition was made by the SHO HumpoGanj on 23/8/2018 and they traced two person and with a engine dhangi (failure of engine) near their tikay. They were brought to Wandoor on the same day.

Consequence of that a joint investigation/interview with the four persons was conducted at Police Station, Ograbrah on 29/8/2018 at about 10.30 Am. (Copy enclosed).

Keeping in view the outcome of the interview it is clear that the fishermen as in the Jarawa reserve are for three days for fishing etc. It is therefore begun to do the needful to the offence done by the above mentioned fishermen. Plz.
