Sub: Submission of report on Joint Patrolling, Reg.

Sir/Madam.

I am to inform you that the Joint Patrolling was conducted on 24/9/2018 and 28/9/2018 in the Jarawa reserved area up to Badabalu. Ten members team (representative of AJVS, Police and Forest Dept.) depart from CPUR on 24/9/2018 at about 1130 hrs. by Engine dinghy and HDPE 90 HP and reached Badabalu at about 1520 hrs. via Thookona.

Patrolling was conducted with our speed boat in the Badabalu area 1530 hrs to 1600 hrs. Night halt at Badabalu (Dinner was arranged by AJVS). On 28/9/2018 morning at about 0630 hrs. patrolling was again conducted in the Nakha and creeks of Badabalu and Badagoja up to 0700 hrs. Halt at Badabalu, had breakfast.

Team proceed to CPUR from Badabalu at about 145 hrs. and reached Collipur at about 1300 hrs via Thookona and JDP No 4. No illegal activities was noticed during patrolling in the area. Jarawas are moving towards Badabalu and Steerentikeny from Thookona and Bamboo Kallala (as seasonal movement.)
