Sub: Submission of Report on Joint Patrolling Reg.

Sir/Madam.

The Joint Patrolling team consisting the representative of AAJS, Police and Forest Dept. out to patrolling in the Jarawa Reserved Area (Western Coastal area of South Andaman) on 23/10/18 and back to Collingpur on 24/10/18 afternoon. 1415 Hrs.

Team proceed to Bamboo Nalha, from Cpur on 23/10/18 at about 1230 Hrs. (towing the HDPE-90 HP. due to shortage of Petrol) reached Bamboo Nalha at about 1645 Hrs; before we reach Bamboo Nalha, a fishing boat was checked by our team members. but no illegal items was found in the boat, there were three crew members. namely Rupechand Hazra, Gurupada Mondal, and Proshin Dhal. all are R/O. Gupta Pakhara, with fishing dinghi bearing Regn. No. INDAN SA NO. 908 MFR. DIYAI, they were on return Journey to Nandor after fishing in Deep Sea. We halt at Bamboo Nalha/ Chotagaji.

On 24/10/18. at about 0830 Hrs. we conducted Patrolling in the Nalha and Radabala Creek with our HDPE-Speed boat. from 8.30 Hrs. to 915 Hrs and 1215 Hrs to 1300 Hrs. and back to SPP. No. 4 by towing with forest boat, and from there to Cpur. by. HDPE-90 HP, reached Cpur by 1415 Hrs. Where as forest boat reached Cpur. by 1515 Hrs. on 24/10/18.
