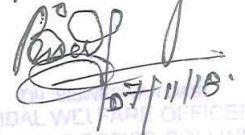
Sir/Madam,

I am to inform you that the Joint patrolling was conducted by the representative of AATS, Police and Forest Dept. on 06/11/2018.

The team consists of six members proceed to Badabalu area (with HDPE-90HP speed boat) from Collingpur on 06/11/2018 at about 0745 hrs. and reached Badabalu by 0900 hrs. via. Bamboo Malka, Chota Goja. After breakfast team conducted patrolling in the creeks and Malka at Badabalu, from 1000 hrs. to 1015 hrs. Halt at Badabalu distributed iron materials and rice (Ranaleey Chadda school) to the Jarawa fellow members and children respectively.
