Sir/Madam,

I am to inform you that the joint patrolling team consists of representative of AAJVS - Dr. Bisweswar Das (T.O.W), Balram Yadav J/S ,Mahesh Mazumder Boat man (operator) with HDPE -90 HP speed boat and Jeethandra nath Halder (DRM) helper of the team, POLICE- SI Someswar Rao i/c OP Tirur, P/C Krishna Rao and P/C Khalid of OP Tirur, FOREST - M. Khalid F/G II, Shyam moorthi dinghy operator with engine dinghy and Anand (labour). The team proceed to Jarawa reserved area from Collinpur near AAJVS field office at about 0800 Hrs on 30/01/2019 and back to collinpur after completion of patrolling at about 1715 Hrs on 30/01/2019.

Joint patrolling team depart from collinpur near AAJVS field office with HDPE 90 HP and Engine Dinghy at about 0800 Hrs and reached Badabalu by 11.30 by towing our HDPE from Pulver Bay(820 am). From badabalu we proced to harbotala chadda and reached there by 1230 Hrs. Where we found a fishing dinghy bearing Regn. No. IND AN SA MO 555 onboard two persons namely Madhava Rao S/O Late vairaghi age 38 yrs R/o Junglighat fisherman colony and Gunnaidh S/o Late Mallaiah age 48 yrs R/o J/ghat F/ Colony. They were very closed to Jarawa habitat. GPS reading Coordinate of the spot was Lat. 11'50'442 N and Lon. 092'30'531 E. They were brought to collinpur and handover to the Police (SHO P/S Ograbraj) on the same day evening for further course of action against them for the offence by entering in to the jarawa reserved area without permission. Subsequently a FIR Was Lodged with SHO, PS Ograbraj against the offender vide FIR No. 9/19 dated 30/01/2019 U/S 7/8 A& N Island PAT Regulation 1956 at about 1845 Hrs.
