Sir/Madam,

This is to inform you that the joint patrolling was conducted on 19/4/2019, Team consist of B. B. Das T.N.O, Jitendra Nath Halder DRM, Kausik Sarkar DRM, Mahesh Majumder DRM. With HDPE-90 HP and a Police Constable from OPTIRUR/JPP-1A. Team depart from Collinpur at about 0730hrs and back to Collinpur by 1130hrs. on the same day.

Joint patrolling team proceed to Badabalu from Collinpur near AAJVS field office at about 0730hrs and reached Badabalu by 0840hrs. via Bamboo Nalha, Badagoja. While proceeding to Bamboo Nalha at about 0800hrs, we found a fishing dinghi coming from open sea, we stopped the dinghi which bearing Rega. No. INDANSA 00786 onboard 03 fisherman namely Gandupali Papa Rao, Mukund Rao and Sunder Rao, all are R/O Wandoor. While checking the dinghi no illegal items were found, instruct them not to enter in to the Jarawa Reserve area. We reached Badabalu by 0940hrs. Patrolling was conducted in the Creek and Nalha of Badagoja, Badabalu from 0845 hrs. to 0945 hrs. Halt at Badabalu. Departure from Badabalu at about 1030 hrs. and reached Collinpur by 1130 hrs. During our visit to that area we found that a group of Jarawa-fellow members were camping at Bamboo-Nalha while no Jarawa were found in Badabalu area. No illegal activities were noticed during patrolling in the area.
