

UT Level for the protection of Jarawas. They shall take follow up action in coordination with relevant Government Departments /Agencies.

(15) There shall be District Level Operation Committee (DLOC) and UT Level Monitoring Committee (UTLMC) for the protection of the Jarawa Tribe as under:

The UT level Committee shall meet once in a quarter and District level Operation Committee once in a month.

(16) The schedule of operationalising the joint surveillance for protection of the Jarawa tribe shall be as under:

- (i) Intensive patrolling by Middle & Outer Layers of protection- **30th November 2014.**
- (ii) AAJVS – Creation of the posts and recruitments before **31st January 2015.**
- (iii) AAJVS – Procurement of equipments required by Joint Patrolling Parties **31st January 2015.**
- (iv) Forest Department - Providing bonga dinghies before **31st January 2015.**
- (v) Operationalisation of all three layers of protection- **1st February 2015.**
