1	Multipurpose field team/ Joint Patrolling Team comprise of JPP, Tirrur & AAJVS staff has been constituted in Tirrur area which visit every Jawara camp regularly and collecting in telligence in a systematic manner	The outer layer coastal patrolling will be done by Indian Coast Guard & Indian Navy.  Inner layer patrolling shall be done by the Police/PMF, Forest & AAJVS
2	01 Forester shall accompany the Joint Patrolling Team on every visit.
