Refer letter F. No. 33-785/2014/JA/PROT/ANTRI/TW/191 15/12/2014, on the subject cited above. The fortnightly action taken report on actionable points in respect of South Andaman District are as under:-

Surveillance mentioned at Sl. No. 5 :- The police personnel of OP Tirur, JPP (Jarawa Protection Post) Tirur No.4 & JPP Tirur No.1 A have been deputed at the edge of the creek at Tirur area, to register the departure and arrival of dingies with all details viz. dingies registration no. owner's name with full address, number of persons boarded with their names and addresses, purpose of carrying persons onboard, date of time of return and similar entries is to be done on their return from sea. The said register is being maintained at OP Tirur.

Fishermen watch group meeting was conducted at OP Wimberlygunj wherein the members of fishermen watch group have also been requested to inform about their departure & arrival of their dingies in sea.

Surveillance mentioned at Sl. No. 6(v) & 7: 02 staff from JPP Tirur No.4 namely HC/632 Vinay Kumar Kerketta and HG/728 Jatin Halder have been deployed for conducting regular joint patrolling along with staff of AAJVS and Forest department. In absence of above police personnel HC/2060 Emmanuel and PC/204 Ramashish of JPP Tirur No.1(A) will join as member of joint patrolling party.

Besides this, the designated staffs of JPPs have also been advised to liaise with Forest department for timely providing of dugout dinghy and to ensure safety equipments required for patrolling should also be provided by AAJVS to JPP Tirur No.4 as mentioned at Sl No. 09 and 10 of said protocol respectively.

However, regular joint patrolling is being carried by the JPP staff along with staffs of AAJVS and Forest Department to make strict vigil over their respective Jarawa reserved areas.
