

The Divisional Forest Officer/SA informed that 01 Forester has been deputed specially for this purpose and that he will accompany the Joint Patrolling Party whenever any patrolling is sent in the area. DFO/SA was also requested to provide the name and contact details of concerned Forester to I/C OP, Tirur.

2. Point No.2: The locational coordinates using GPS alongwith photography is being done in all cases of illegal intrusion apprehended by the Joint Patrolling team.

3. Point No.3 : The regular reports regarding follow up action on inputs received from Multipurpose Field team is being sent by the Tribal welfare Officer to AAJVS/TW for analysis.

4. Point NO.4: The Executive Secretary, AAJVS was requested to send a reminder to the DC/South Andaman/Director of Health Services/Director Tourism for issuing necessary directions to owners of Hotels/Dhabas as per the protocol surveillance.

5. Point No: 5: The movement of Fishing boats in the Collinpur Creek is being monitored by the staff of OP/JPP Tirur and directions are being followed strictly^{as} contained in the 'Protocol of Surveillance'

In this connection Assistant Director, Fisheries, Shri Arif Mustafa informed that this area falls under the jurisdiction of Ferrargunj Panchayat Samity and that there are 42 registered boats in Collinpur area and 80 fishermen have been issued Identity Card from the Fisheries Department alongwith safety equipments like life jacket.

The middle layer patrolling in speed boat and inner layer of Joint patrolling parties is being sent on daily basis. The schedule of patrolling is attached herewith for perusal.

6. Point No.6 (ii): May be taken up by UT level monitoring committee regarding the protection of Jarawas from the outsiders especially from foreigners.
