Kindly refer my letter No. 55, 103 dt. 22/3/95 and 7th July 95 and also letter No. 126 dt. 16/8/95. Mr. K. Alagar R/o H/Bay has ordered to stitched the clothes for Onges by the then O/c o/s. S/C. The Tailor had handed over some clothes (stitched) but not fully for Onges of S/C but no clothes were handed over by him till date. On 11-Sept. 95 I demanded the clothes personally then Mr. K. Alagar (The Tailor) clearly stated that he is not going to handover any clothes to me and also use some bad language, and ask me to do whatever I can.
